- In the continued effort to reduce plastic waste, Elewana no longer uses **plastic drinking straws** at any of their properties. In a groundbreaking initiative in East Africa, Elewana is introducing biodegradable straws that decompose in 90-120 days into a benign state that does no harm to our environment.
- Guests staying at Elewana Loisaba Terred Camp can learn more about the conservation work that goes on in the area by visiting the new **Loisaba Conservation Center**. To share information about the challenges that wildlife is facing in the highlands of Kenya, a team of conservationists and sociologists is developing educational messaging – from Loisaba Conservancy, The Maasai Conservancy, Space for Giants and the San Diego Zoo Global – have created this new education conservation facility.
- It's now possible to **fly from Masai Mara to the Serengeti** on a daily scheduled flight operated by malindi airlines – An Kenya of Safari link on the Kenya side and Coastal Aviation in Tanzania. Passengers fly from Masai Mara to Migori, where they exit Kenya and are driven one hour to Nairobi, where they go through T2 customs and immigration. From Nairobi, they hop another flight to the Serengeti airstrip.
