Jessie and I are so thankful for the wonderful support we get from the trade. As always, we're just a phone call or email away.

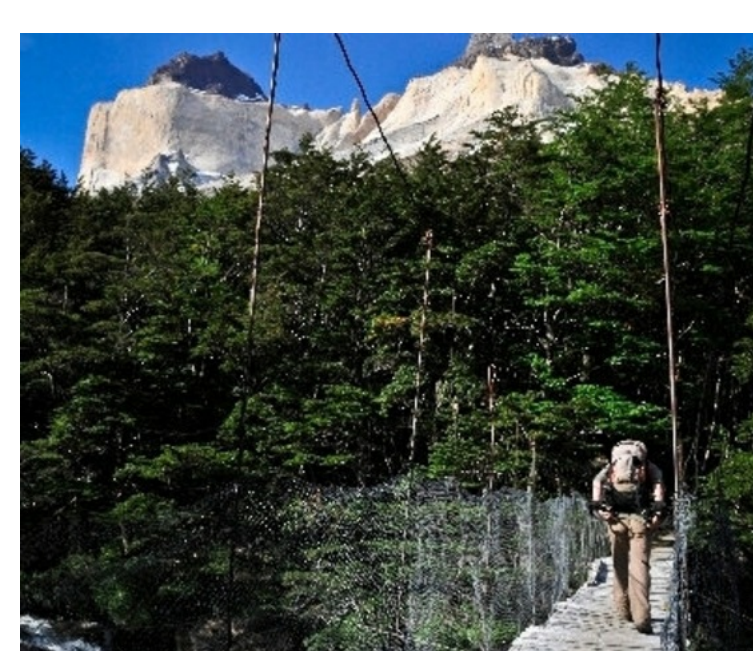
